The DTGov project layers Design Time Governance functionality on top of an S-RAMP repository. These two projects work together to provide the following:

- Store and Govern artifacts
- Deployment Lifecycle Management
- Custom Governance Workflows

- Apache Ant 1.7 or newer to use the installer
- Maven 3.0.3 or newer
